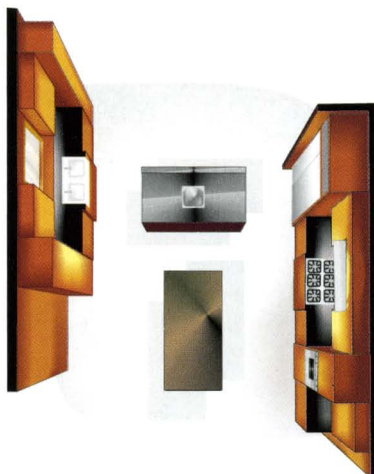

# Historically Home

IT WAS AN incredible project from the beginning when Lisa Principe of CKS Design Studio was selected along with New York-based designer Seborn Ragsdale of Seborn Ragsdale Interiors to essentially gut and remodel this family estate home, originally built in the 1800s. The primary goal for this home was to create a room comfortable for a large family with small children, while concurrently retaining the historical elements in the rest of the house.

The kitchen was made more functional by removing an adjoining wall to add space for the two islands and breakfast nook. Seating is incorporated in both islands, at different heights, to accommodate children and adults. To increase the convenience of preparation and cleanup, modern stainless appliances, multiple sinks and dishwashers accommodate large meals and entertaining.

The perimeter features white painted inset cabinetry with period hardware, beadboard, turnings and clover leaf punched steel inserts. For contrast, the islands are finished in a silvery blue-green paint, and a quarter-sawn oak desk and hutch are stained in a rich dark-cocoa brown. Perimeter countertops, created in cherry plank, are stained to coordinate with the beams and paneling at the ceiling. The finished project is incredible, suiting family and designer alike. «
